Shawna Drummond (Principal Educator)

1. Clay for kids is an amazing hands-on (and Calgary-based) program that brings the curriculum to life with their unique clay and pottery projects. We see Clay for Kids as a grade 4 project that students will get to experience in their final year here at NWE. In years past we have always chosen their clay projects linked to the Social studies curriculum. This year, we would like to continue that tradition by making an "Environmental Scene" through their virtual kit. We have learned about Alberta's 6 regions, specifically looking at landforms, vegetation and climate and will be able to include these elements on our environmental plaques.

The cost for this project would be \$15/student PLUS \$3/student for the slip glaze (paint/colour).

53 students x \$18 = \$954 + GST.
